




"First base because it is easy to learn for beginners."

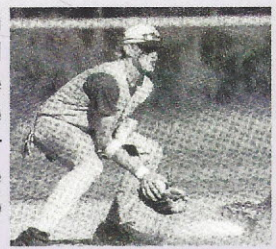


MVP Philip Wilkins went on to pitch at College of Charleston and Francis Marion before entering the Minors Rookie League with the Detroit Tigers.
