

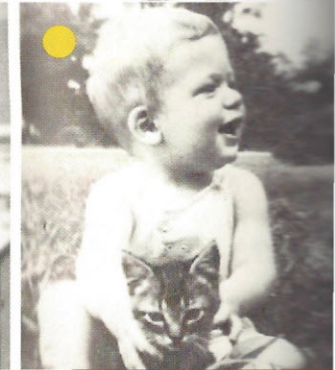
REMEMBERING...
