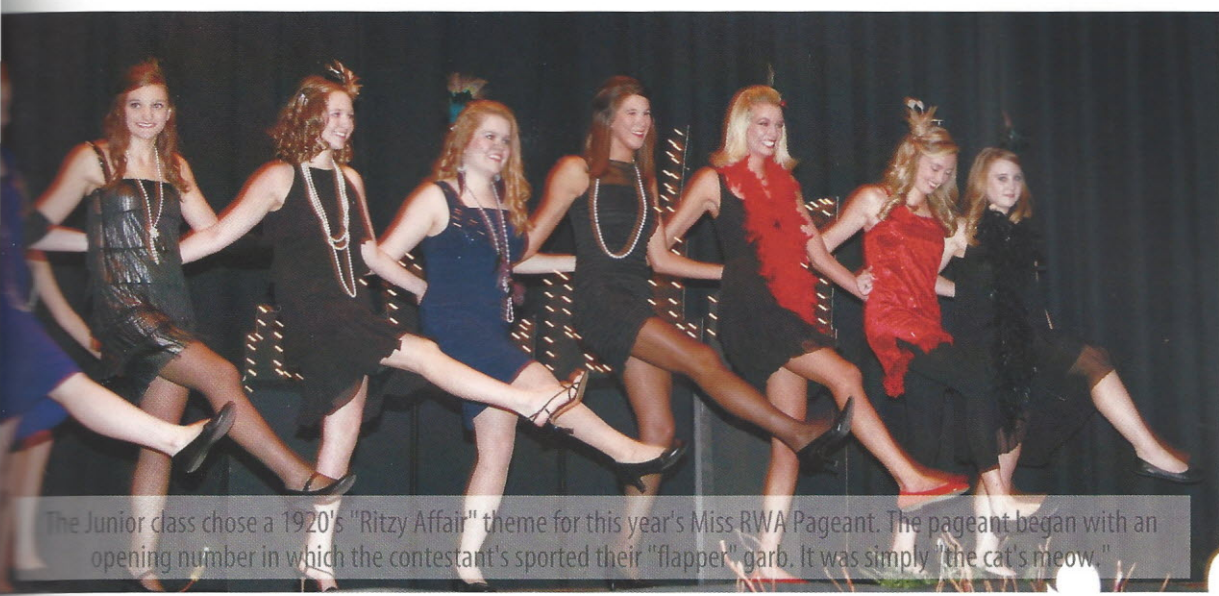
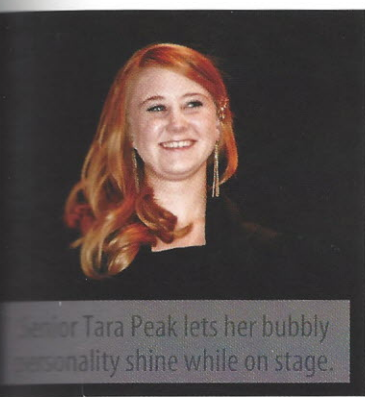


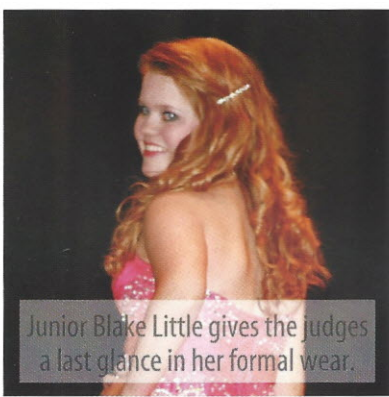
Miss RWA pageant a ritzy affair.



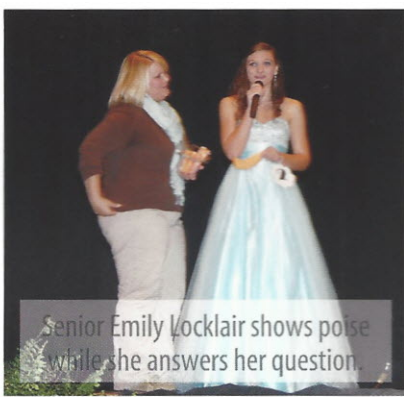

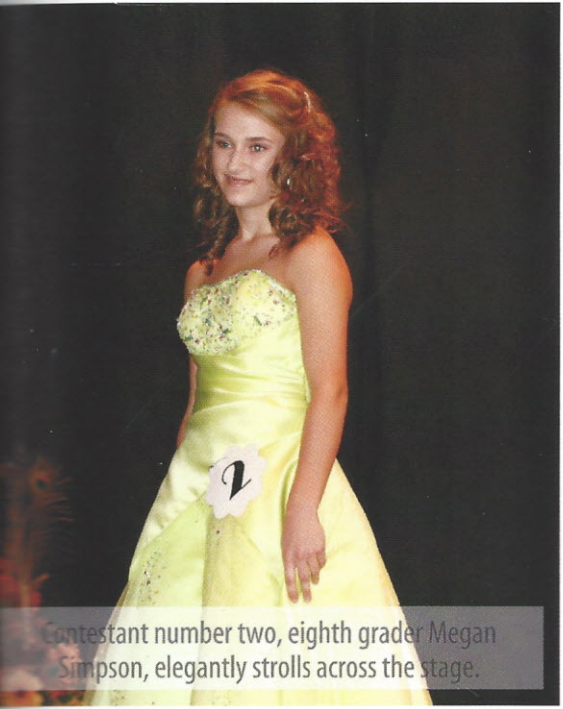
Senior Tara Peak lets her bubbly personality shine while on stage.



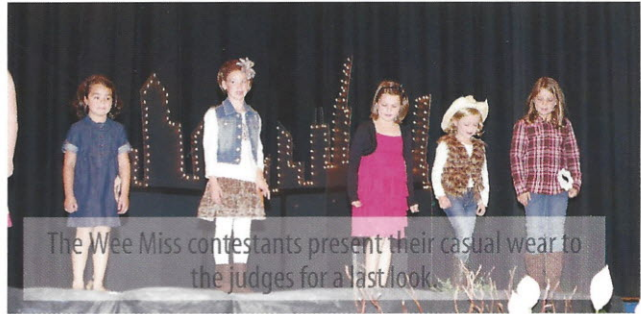
Junior Blake Little gives the judges a last glance in her formal wear.
