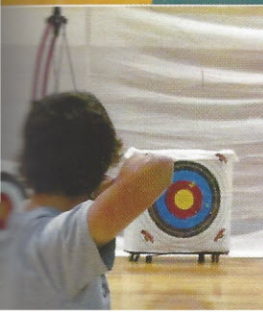


winter
