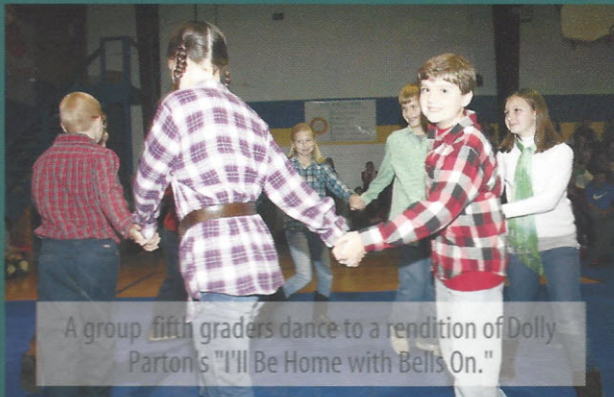


Christmas

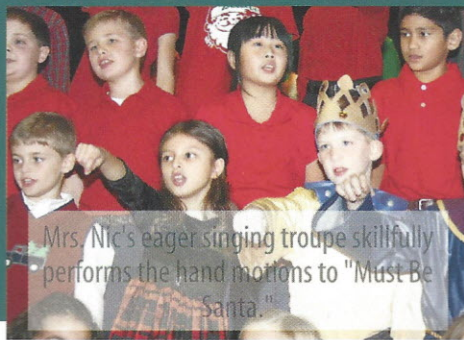
A group fifth graders dance to a rendition of Dolly Parton's "I'll Be Home with Bells On."



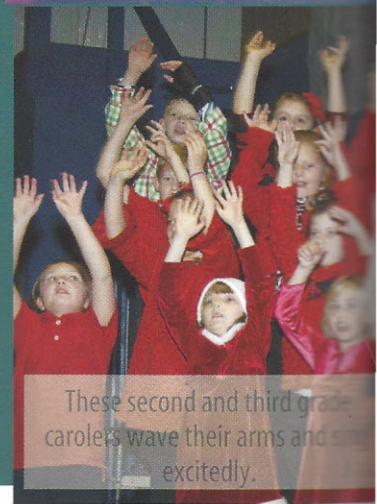
Who else could arrive on such a festive, Christmas night? Santa!
