



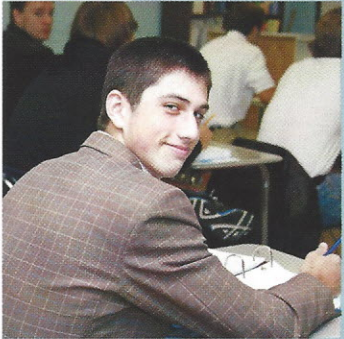

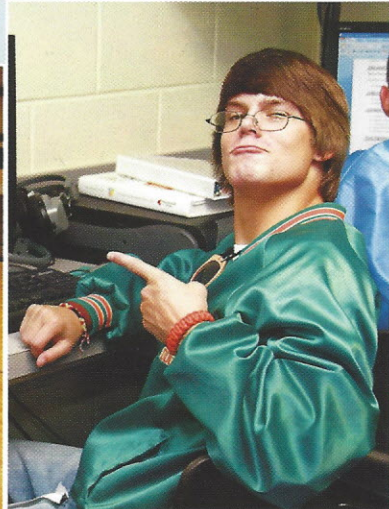

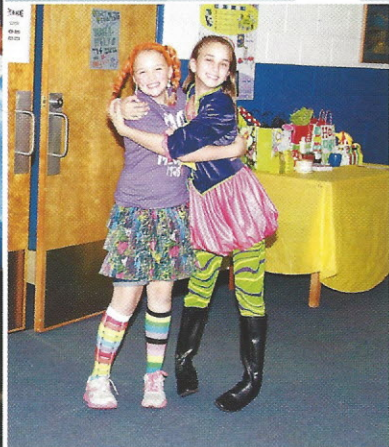
Smurf. Eighth grader Todd Simpson leaps over Bryant Carvalho during lunch break. The two friends dressed as smurfs together for Character Day.
