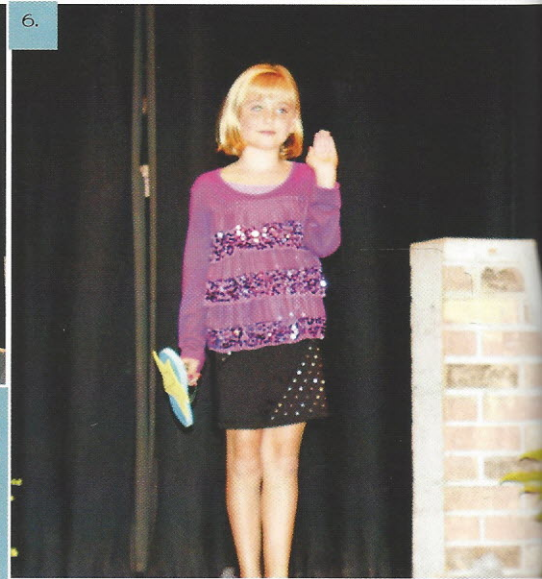
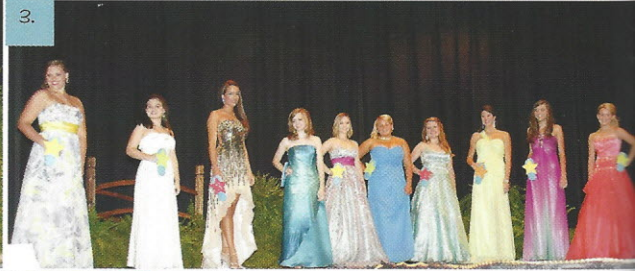
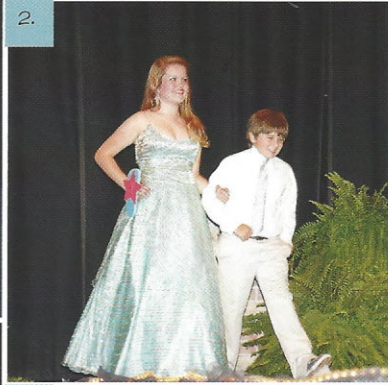
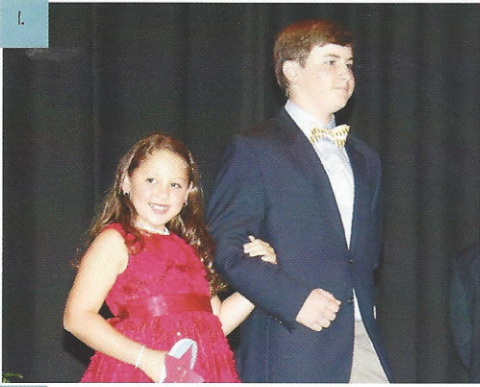


A [walk] to remember
