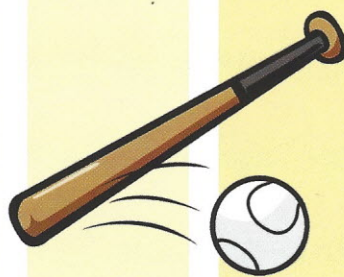


Batter Up. Mitchell Gibbons anticipates the pitch from a Fairfield Central player. Mitchell contributed to his team's success throughout the season in many different ways.
