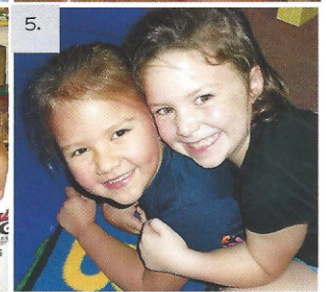
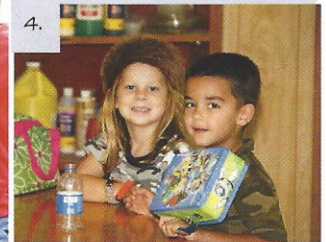

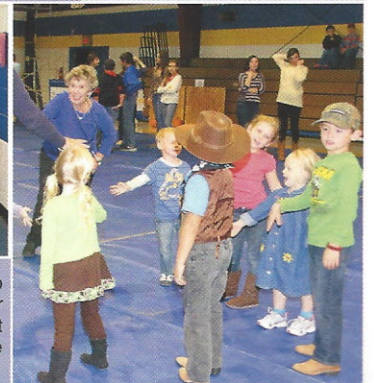
Tune In. Character Day is one of the most spirited days in K5. This group enjoyed dressing up as their favorite hero and sharing their favorite episode or movie part.
