



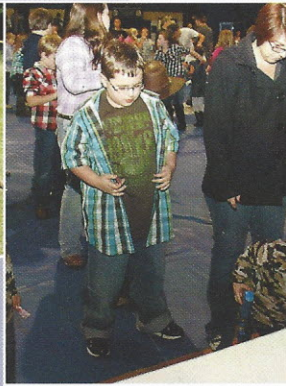

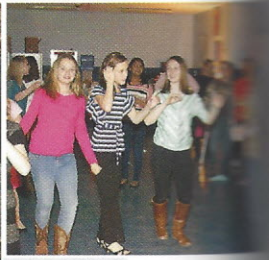
**Is This Right?** Hudson shares his answer with the class. Collaboration was a beneficial study technique as they prepared for tests and quizzes.

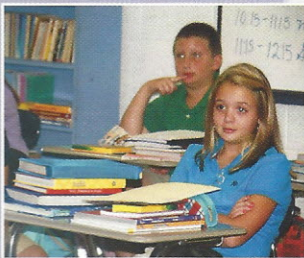

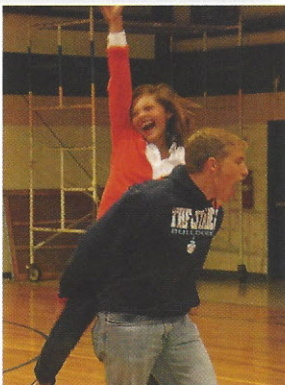

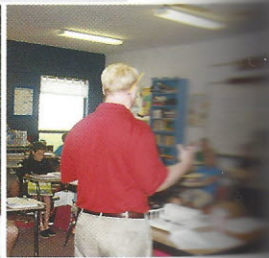
