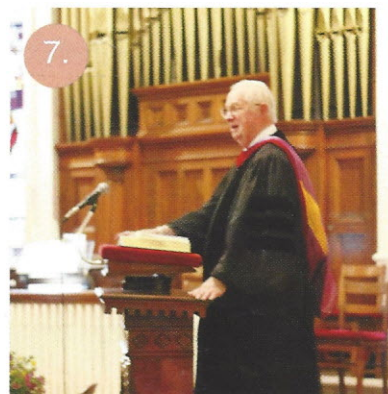
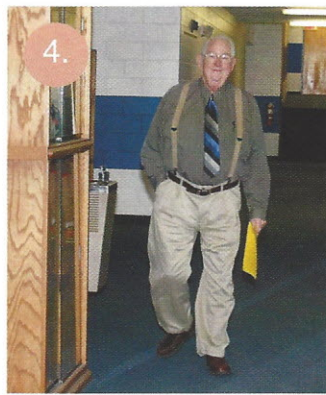
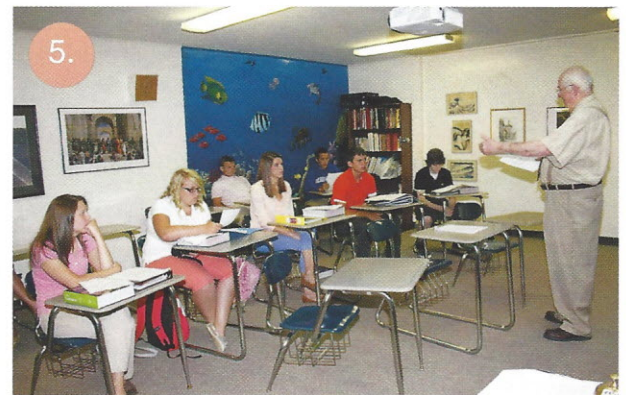
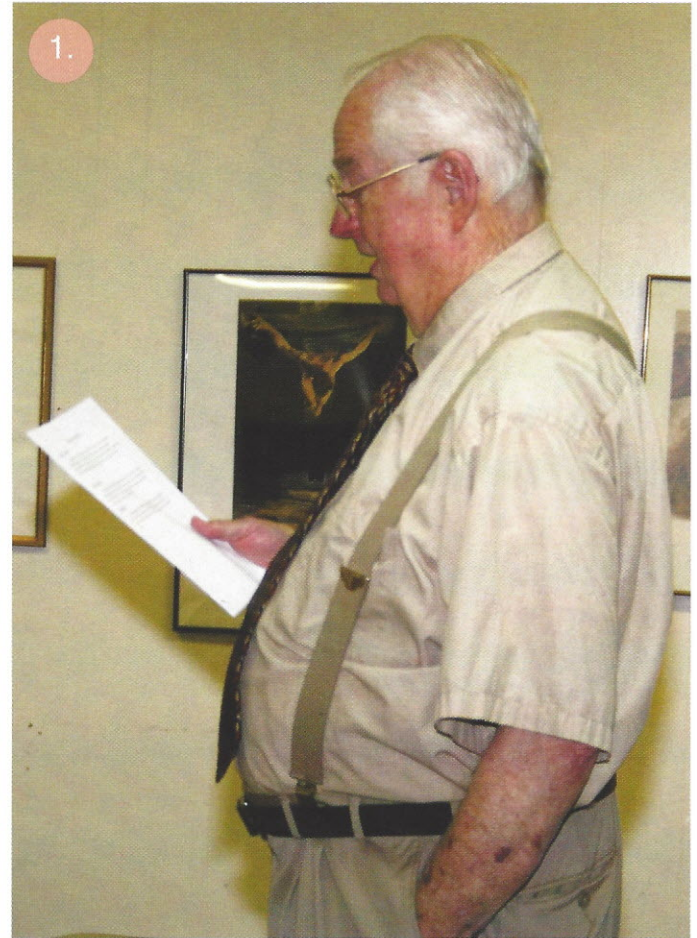


Dedication
