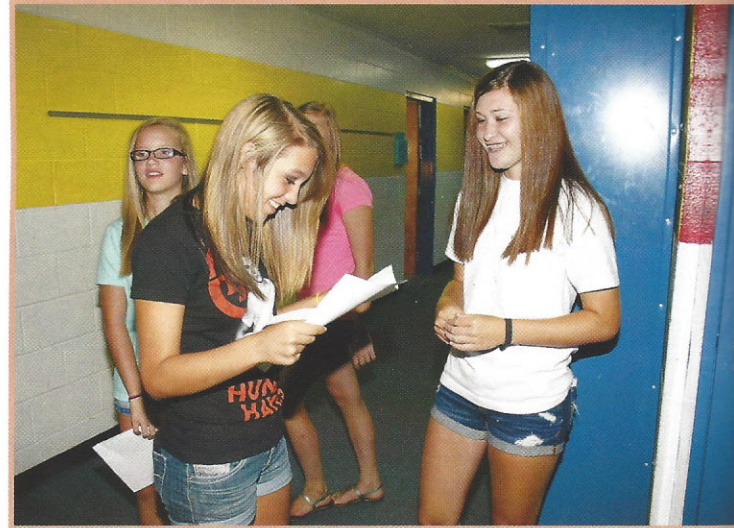


Open House
