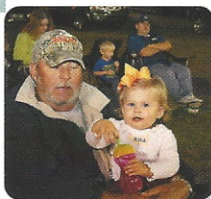
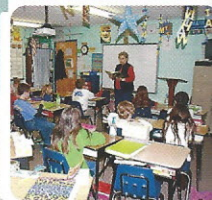


# FALL
