

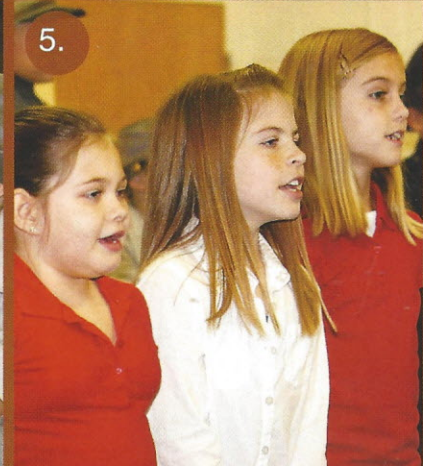
Veterans Day Program

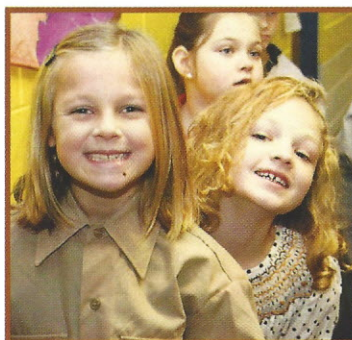
Women in War.
