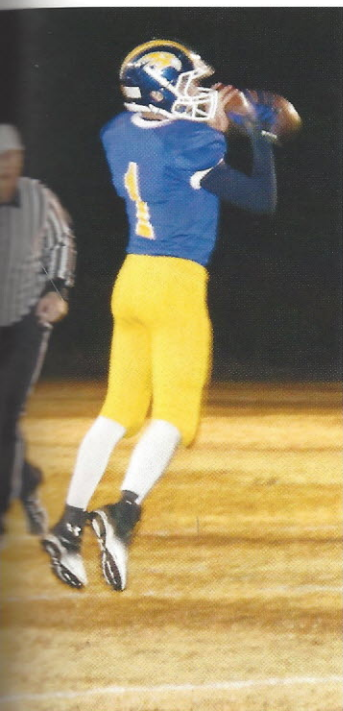
## *Tossing & Running the Pigskin*

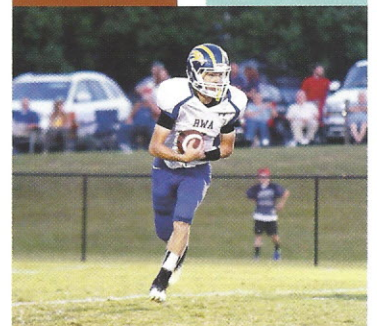
**Heisman Time.** Quarterback Matt Taylor does his best Heisman pose. Matt truly played well this season, performing multiple Heisman worthy plays.
