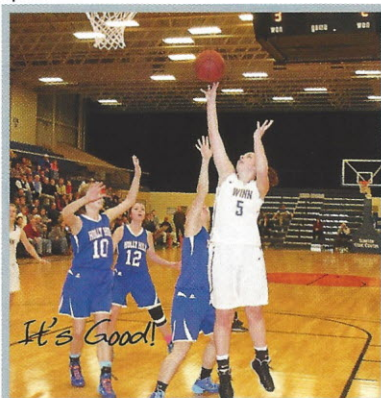


We Did it! Calee and Kim share a congratulatory hug after winning the state title. Their friendship shined throughout every game during the season.

Fast Break! Lydia and Cassie run their lanes during a fast break. These two greatly improved their skills during the season.



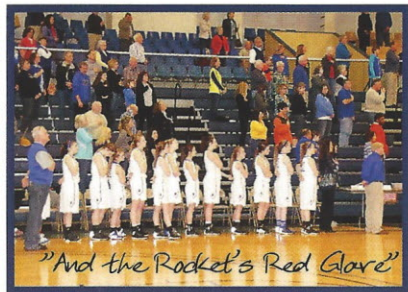
