

Ridgeway's historic "Brick House" has recently been renovated and established as a Community and Youth Center. Called "The Century House" because it is more than 100 years old, this ante-bellum home of Mr. James B. Coleman, an early settler and planter, was built by plantation labor and was the first brick house in this area. Of Civil War fame, Gen. G. T. Beauregard established his headquarters here on February 17, 1865, in advance of Gen. W. T. Sherman's march through Fairfield County.
