



Fairfield County is not only known for its beautiful colonial homes and Southern tradition, but it has on the Broad River one of the most modern nuclear power plants in the nation. The Parr Atomic Plant is the only site in the world where electricity can be generated by using the three principle sources of power: water, coal, and the atom.

The plant was completed in 1963 by the Carolina Virginia Nuclear Power Association, Inc. and has as its goal a forty-six million dollar experiment to develop a nuclear furnace.
