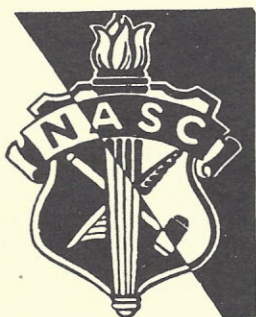
Representing the entire student body, the Student Council strives for those things which will be for the best interest of our school. The elected representatives discuss and act on problems which are presented to the council.

This year has been a successful one for the Beta Club. The highest event was the State Beta Club convention that was held in Columbia. The year ended with a picnic held in honor of the Senior members.



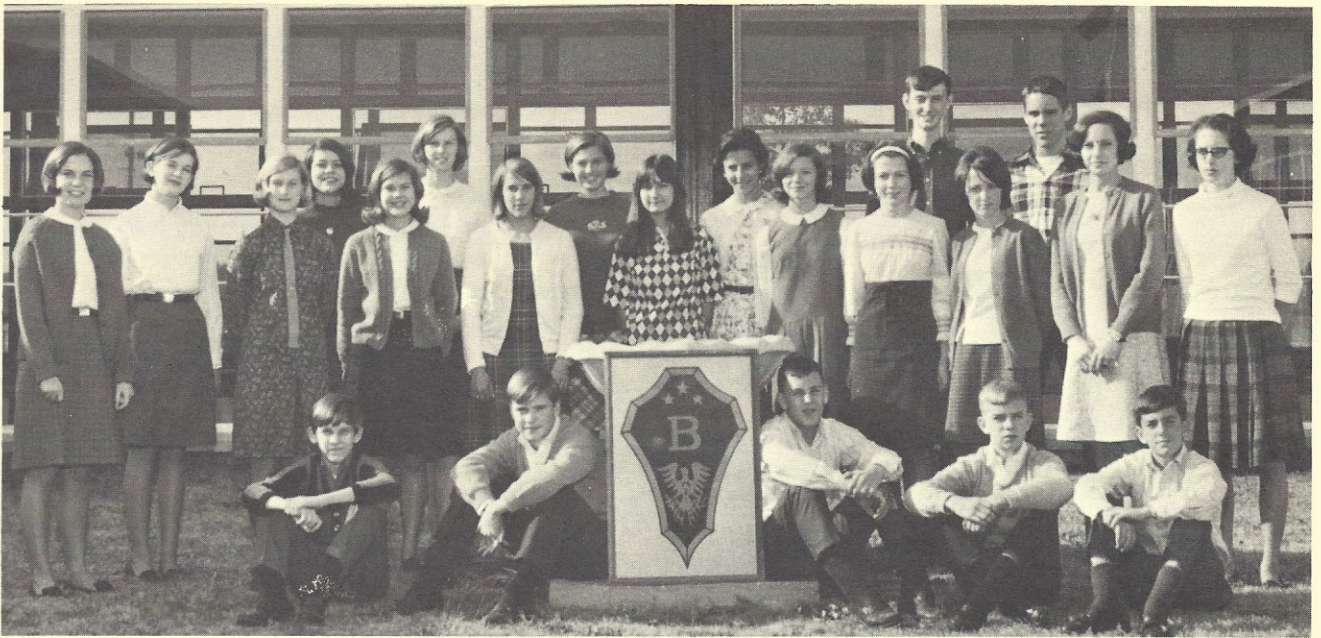

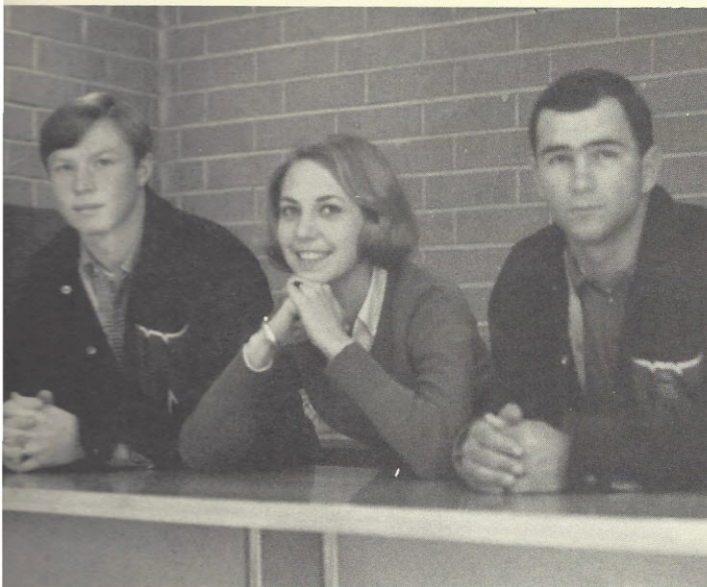
# ***JUNIOR BETA CLUB***

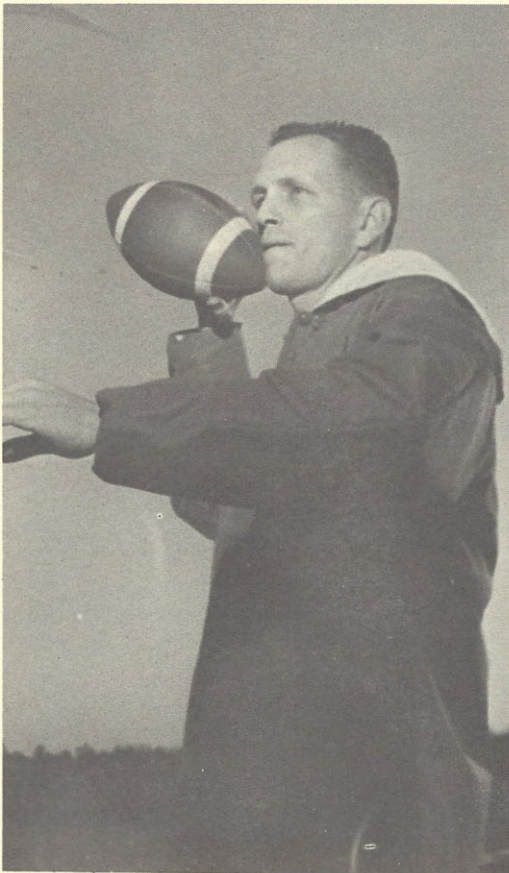


### THE SUCCESS STORY

## *WHAT IS A SENIOR?*

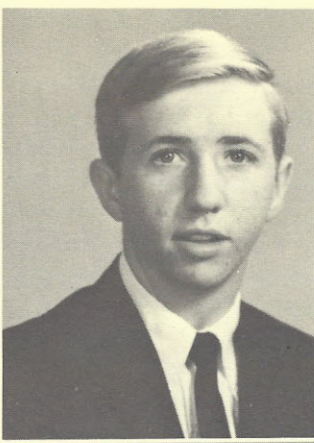
