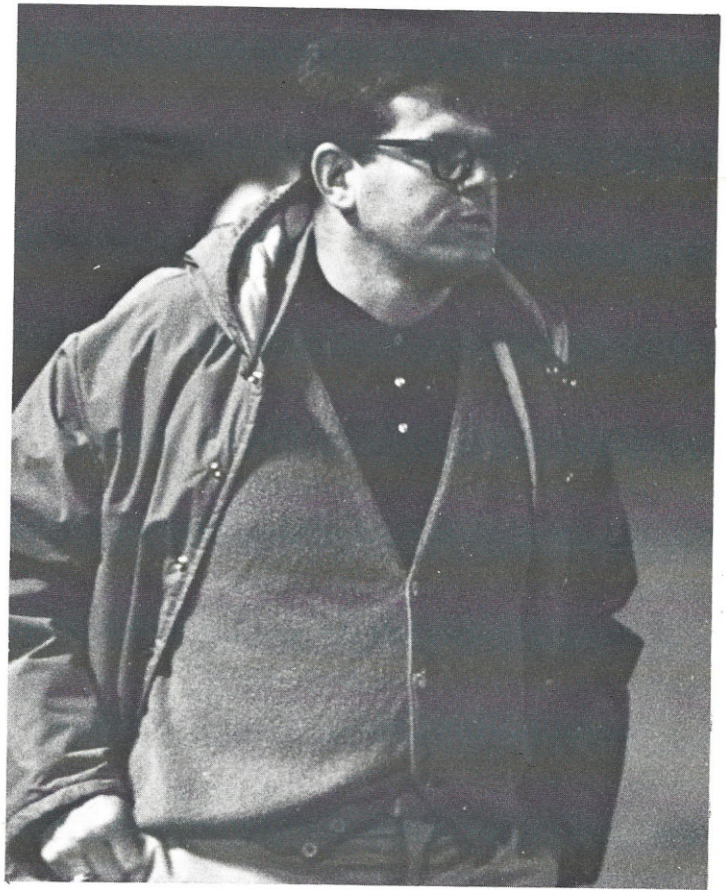
The band played "Dixie", the team rushed onto the field as the crowd cheered wildly, and the 1968 football season was underway.

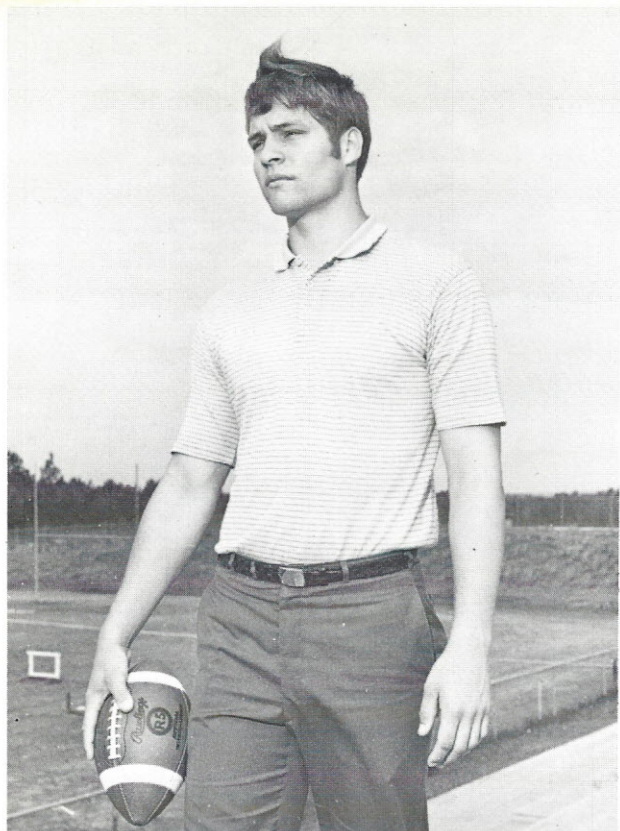

Yes, football was all of this . . . and more. For the Wildcats of Winnsboro High School fought to a 8 - 2 record and a tie for the Conference Championship.

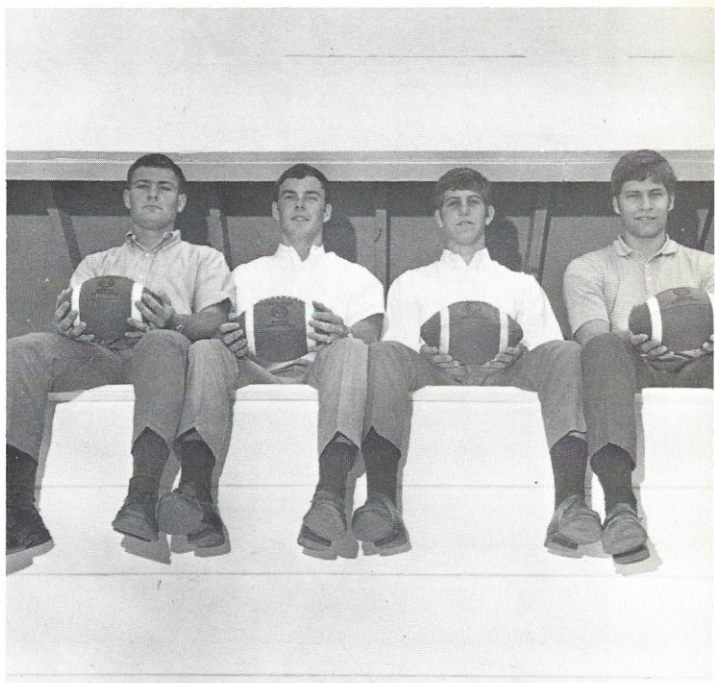
