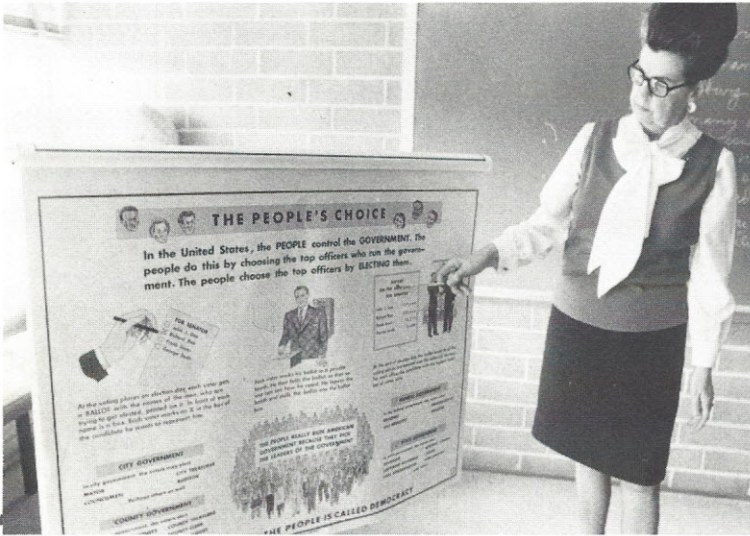
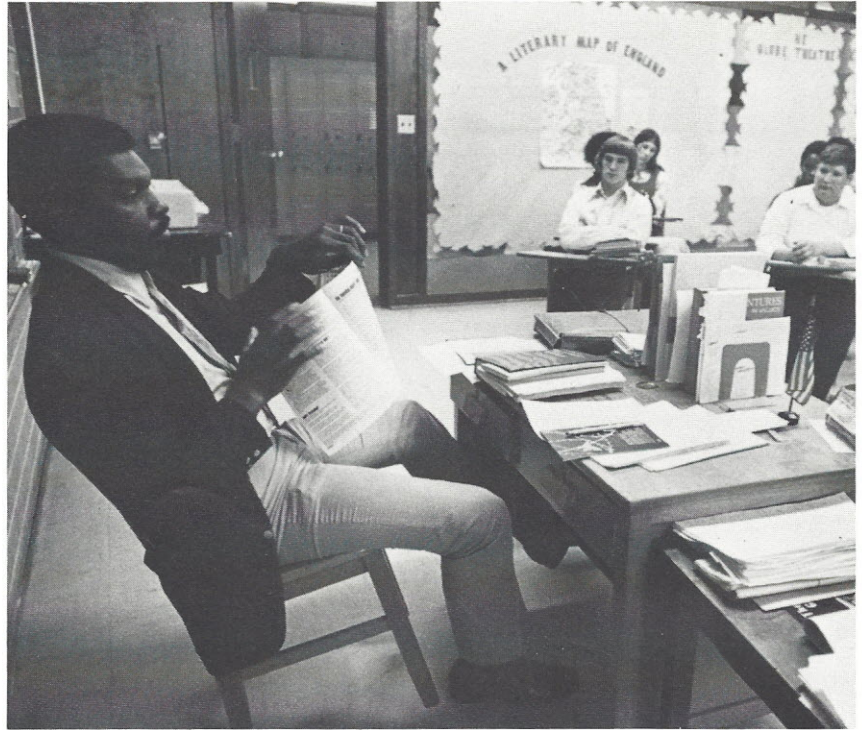


SOCIAL STUDIES
