
The English Department helps students acquire knowledge of literature and the English language. Proper use of grammar is stressed through themes and papers pertaining to literature which the students have studied.






SCIENCE





SOCIAL STUDIES

The Social Studies Department tries to present historical background material through history, government, and geography, and helps for modern living in psychology. The department prepares the students to become citizens of the nation.








ART


