Likewise his assistant and upon whom this burden fell after Yates death (Raymond Hefner) also died suddenly and all the information these two had gathered was turned over to the Catawba County Historical Society.

I have compleated my lienage from Jehn the second son of Pioneer Andreas Killian and have three or four ether lines to finish that may be published in another beek when ~~see~~ when authorized by the Klan.

I was partly reared one mile south of Startown with my Great Aunts and Uncle Catherine, Ann, and Julius Wilson who lived oppsite Andrew Wilson, I remember a great many of the people living at or near Startown.
