The history is in neway compleat as cousin Yates Killian died before he could secure the ancestoral linage of the numerous descendants. Likewise his assistant and upon whom this burden fell after Yates death (Raymond Hefner) also died suddenly and all the information these two had gathered was turned over to the Catawba County Historical Mediety.

I have compleated my lienage from John the second son of Pioneer Andreas Killian and have three or four other lines to finish that may be published in another book when when authorized by the Klan.

I was partly reared one mile south of Startown with my Great Aunts and Uncle Catherine, Ann, and Julius Wilson who lived appsite Andrew Wilson, I remember a great many of the people living at or near Startown.
