As you can tell as you pass by or visit our community, we have spent a good deal of time, effort, and money (nearly \$8,000) in our stewardship of Daniels Cemetery. The older section has been the focus of our efforts in cleaning and repairing the stones and lining up the rows. The older stones that were deteriorating so badly have been repaired and placed in concrete to lessen their decay. We still need to fill in the low sections and sow grass there. There is as yet plenty left to do! As we near the completion of this renovation, we need for you to assist us with the following items ... if you can help.

1. Do you know of any unmarked graves in Daniels Cemetery? Contact Pastor immediately so proper identification and records may be made.
2. Does your family have any graves that do not yet have headstones? Would you consider providing them soon so we can bring to completion our work in the old section?
3. Does your family have any Revolutionary or Civil War participants in the cemetery? Let Pastor know in writing, if possible.
4. If you as individuals or as families would like to make a donation for this work, please mark it clearly for the Cemetery Renovation Project. The generous gifts from years past; from individuals, family reunions, and church budgets; have enabled us to maintain the cemetery. Your gifts now will help us replace those funds used for this project.
5. How can we help you? Frequently we get letters asking for family and burial information from our past. Do you need anything we can provide. Do you have records we need?

We want to continue to be good stewards for this hallowed ground. The souls that rest there are our precious past and heritage. I think you will be pleased to see the results of our recent efforts.
