18-Month-Old Lee Anne Walker Lies Gravely Ill; Hospital Costs Mount



Little Lee Anne Walker lies ill in the Baptist Hospital in Columbia, victim of a rare and usually fatal disease. The only child of Billy and Janice Walker of Winnsboro, she is eighteen months old.

The tiny girl was taken out of the intensive care unit on Saturday for the first time since entering the hospital on December 29. Most of that time she was in a coma. Mr. Walker says that Lee Anne cries now, they know because they can see tears in her eyes. She can make no noise; a tracheotomy had to be performed to enable her to breathe. She is receiving nourishment by tubes.

Lee Anne has to have someone with her constantly. Private nurses around the clock are expen-

sive, and since the Walkers cannot afford them, Mrs. Walker has stayed with the child continually, occasionally grabbing a nap on the waiting room couches and in a cot set up in the child's room. Mr. Walker, a Uniroyal, Inc. employee, relieves her when he is not working.

At first, doctors offered little hope that Lee Anne would survive. Even now, her life hangs in the balance. And should she live, she may suffer some permanent disability. However, since she has already survived longer than most other known victims of her disease, her parents cling to the hope that she will pull through.

The Walkers have little insurance, and in the first twelve days of Lee Anne's hospitalization the bill had risen to \$2,500. No one knows how much longer she will remain at the hospital. Mrs. Walker hasn't been able to work since her daughter's illness.

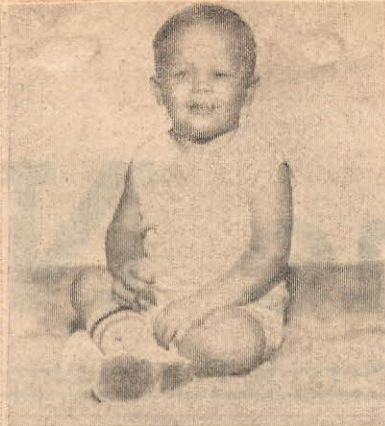
