

Re-enactment at Concord Church

A re-enactment on Sunday, November 7, will commemorate the story of a Confederate officer and his lifelong friend, the former slave Isaiah Moore.

The re-enactment will take place at Concord Presbyterian Church in Woodward in Fairfield County, ten miles north of Winnsboro.

On Sunday, Nov. 7 at 10:30 a.m. the re-enactment events will begin with a march to Concord Presbyterian Church and an 11 a.m. worship service. After the service, military honors will be rendered in the graveyard and Major Brice and Isaiah Moore will be honored. Wreaths will be also laid in the graves of each man.

During the event, re-enactors will be in period uniform, and other re-enactors will present first person impressions of people of the community that they have researched.
