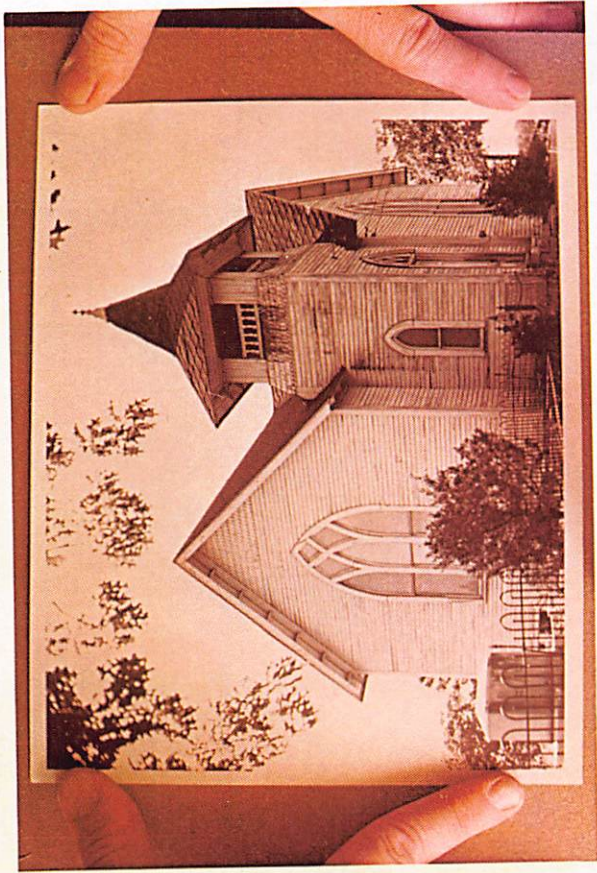

This 3.5"x5" color print of Greenbrier Methodist Church was taken by me (James W. Green III, Route 5, Box 720, Winnsboro, SC 29180-9516 (803) 635-9236) in mid-1976 from the (approximately 8"x10") print probably belonging to Bobby Rutland (postmaster of Rion). He says he found the picture in his mother's effects & assumes she bought it from Ernest Ferguson of Winnsboro who took the photo about 1952 or 1953, a couple of months or so before it was torn down by John Ballentine & Sam Castles Sr., who used the wood in their houses. He (Rutland) says the church had hoped to use the wood from the old church to build the new church which they were constructing starting in 1952, but found they couldn't so sold it to said Castles & Ballentine. He (Rutland) says this church stood from the early 1890's to the early 1950's & thinks this was the 3rd building.
