4. Old Jackson Creek Church Ruins

1775

This graveyard is hauntingly beautiful beside the ruins of Jackson Creek Presbyterian Church, one of the oldest Scots-Irish Presbyterian congregations. Ancient marble slabs and vaults inside the granite walls describe many of the buried as having immigrated from the Ulster Irish counties.

The largest and most impressive monument is a tall granite shaft mounted on a tiered base. It is a memorial to a national hero, Lieutenant James Clark who died a hero's death in the Mexican War in 1847. The impressive marker was erected by his fellow comrades and the day that it was unveiled was one of the memorable events of its time.

Great statesmen, heads of state and local government as well as representatives attended the ceremonies where his bullet-pierced flag, side arms and swords, and a national medal of valor were presented to his family.

There are many old graves in this old cemetery. Some are unmarked. Some of the markers are so old that it is impossible to read. The ones I could read had no record of war service. Some were the right ages to serve in the Revolution War and the Civil War, and possible the War of 1812. Most are of Scotch and Irish descent, so I know the Scotch-Irish are famous for their fighting. There are not any markers of any type to indicate they have served in any wars. I am not familiar with the Lebanon community, but I know it must be stories and legends about the many people buried at the Old Rock Church. It would be interesting to hear these stories and legends passed down thru the generations. This is an interesting place.
