 whereas a marriage is shortly to intended to  
 be had and solemnized between the said George  
 Adams and Eliza Hollis with whom the  
 said George Adams is to have and receive the  
 said property and as for her Marriage portion  
 it is covenanted and agreed by and between the  
 said parties to these presents and manner and  
 form following (viz) first the said George Adams  
 for himself his heirs executors and administra-  
 tors with covenant and agree to & with the  
 said Eliza Hollis her heirs and assigns that  
 they the said George Adams & Eliza Hollis his  
 intended wife in case the said intended mar-  
 riage shall be had & solemnized by some good  
 and sufficient conveyance or conveyances in  
 the Law shall retain & assure all the said pro-  
 perty with the appurtenances whereof she the  
 said Eliza Hollis is seized as aforesaid or and  
 to herself and the heirs of her body the property  
 is aforesaid in Witness whereof we have hereunto  
 set our hand and Seal this 28<sup>th</sup> day of May 1892

Know all men by these presents that I Hugh  
Lavender of Fairfield District and State aforesaid  
for and in consideration of nine Hundred and  
fifty Dollars to me in hand paid by John Hall  
Junior of the state and District aforesaid have  
granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these  
presents do grant bargain sell and release unto  
the said John Hall Junr all that plantation or  
tract of Land containing two hundred acres  
situate in the district aforesaid on the Horse  
Branch waters of water creek bounded on a line  
running N.W. by land owned by the Estate of Berry  
Hollis, and John Hall, S.W. by John Hall's and  
Cameron's Land, S.E. & E. by David Lavender's Land  
and hath such form and marks as a plat there  
of laid down in the margin of a deed of Hugh  
Lavender represents, being part of a tract of  
Land containing three hundred and fifty acres  
originally granted to David Montgomery the sixth  
day of January A.D. 1753. Together with all and

appurtenances to the said premises belonging or
