We have looked thru our records and here is what we found.

First, South Carolina did not start keeping marriage licenses until around 1910, so unless you can find it in church records or a newspaper notice, you we are out of luck.

I also searched for a death record for Lizzie Harrell, but did not find one for her.

I did find the death record that you cited for William and I think that he is your William. In the 1880 Census for Kershaw County it shows a Henry Addison-28 with the following family: wife-Frances-23 and children: Mattie-6, William-5, John-5, Nelley-2, Elizabeth -7 and Nora-0. Also there is a death certificate for Eliza Mickle who died on September 28, 1928 at 41 years in Kershaw County, she lists her parents as Henry Addison and Frances Qualls. These dates match the Eliza Addison you listed and her birth year matches the Elizabeth in the 1880 Census.

We were unable to find anything for Napoleon and Josephine Harrell.

It appears that these families lived in Kershaw County, you can go to www.catawba-wateree.scgen.org to contact the society in Kershaw County and see if they can help you.

Hope this is of some help.

Good Morning,

I live in Pennsylvania and am looking for information on my maternal grandparents, William Addison and Lizzie Harrell. I am the youngest child of Margaret, their 3rd youngest child.

Lizzie Harrell was born in 1882 in Wateree, Kershaw County to Napoleon Harrell and Josephine, his wife (I don't know Josephine's last name). Lizzie married William Addison around 1901 and moved to Fairfield County. According to the 1910 census, they lived in Township 6 in Fairfield County. I know that Lizzie died around 1932-1934 but I don't know the exact date of her death and have been unable to find her death certificate, even on Death Certificates for South Carolina. I would like a copy of her marriage license (if available) and her death certificate.

Lizzie had one sibling, Hammie.

William was born in 1876 in Ridgeway, SC. I believe that his parents were Henry Addison and Frances Qualls. He lived in Wateree, Kershaw County until around 1901 when he moved backed to Fairfield County. He also died between 1932-1934. I have a record of a death of a William Addison on April 19, 1932 but I am not quite sure that this is my William. The death certificate lists his wife as Adline and his parents as William Addison and Frances Qualls.
