Richard Wilm of Tennessee sold
William Adger (sometimes written
Edgar) two small tracts of land
on Little River for an undisclosed
sum on Oct. 13, 1813. Two of the
acres of land were completely
surrounded by land already
owned by William Adger. The
other tract of 8 acres lay on
Runnels Branch, Little River, and
was bounded on the north by
Adger land.

On Sept 29, 1794 Robert Ellison
of Warrborough sold Richard
Wilm 100 acres of land on Runnels
Branch; Little River for 10 pounds
sterling

John Winn sold Robert
Ellison the following lots
for 40 pounds in 1785
The one quarter acre lot # 40
on Werhington Street and the
following one half acre lots on
Congress St. # 44, 38, 39.
