the said *George Agnew* his Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, will be entitled to receive from this Office the Sum of *Fifteen Shillings and four pence*

on the *demand* one Year's Interest on the principal Sum of *Eleven pounds*

and the like Interest annually *of Res. Gen. Assembly 1783*

The said *George Agnew* his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, will be entitled also to receive, and shall be paid, if demanded, the principal Sum of *Eleven pounds*

on the *Eighteenth May 1787*

And the said *George Agnew* his Executors, Administrators or Assigns, may make any Purchases at any Public Sales of Confiscated Property, (except such as shall be ordered by the Legislature for special Purposes;) and this INDENT shall be received in Payment.

For the true Performance of the several Payments in Manner above-mentioned, the PUBLIC TREASURY is made liable, and the FAITH of the STATE pledged by the aforefaid ACT:
