2 - William Aikens in the 1830 census of Fairfield Co SC

I think the William Aiken that I am working on is a different one from the one you refer to that is ancestor of Val - that is why the information on the families don't FIT.

I found two William Aiken/s in the 1830 census of Fairfield Co SC

The one I have married to Hannah [?Thompson?] is in 1830 census living next to John Wiley and Samuel Wiley

**is yours in the attached census labeled - X1830 USfederalcensus312768869
William Aiken living next - David Smith**

I wonder if some of the Fairfield county genealogists have the two families intermingled??

I am only going by the information I got from William and Hannah Aiken's rev. War pension applications; plus the census I found them in at ancestry.com

my William Aiken seems to have moved to Chester by the 1840 census;

He d. in 1844

I don't have a deed for him moving to Chester Co SC -- maybe someone at the archives could look up this deed.

The Jane Fatheree who is a descendant of this Aiken/Wylie family lives in TX - I will send her your email address she can contact you.

Below are the census for my William Aiken m. to Hannah - with known children Catherine, Sarah, Nancy, James & Martha [these are all the children I know about]

Catherine m. Joseph Wylie - d. 1826, son of Joseph Wylie

Nancy m. John Wylie, son of Joseph Wylie -- buried at Sion Presbyterian Cemetery

Sarah m. Samuel Wylie, son of Joseph Wylie -- buried at Old Catholic in Chester Co SC.

I don't know who son James Aiken married.

There is a daughter Martha Aiken - who I think never married
