Allyn, Robert (Conn). Sergeant 1st Connecticut, 10th February, 1777; Ensign, 1st November, 1777; 2d Lieutenant, 1st July, 1780; transferred to 5th Connecticut, 1st January, 1781; retired 1st January, 1783. (Died 1811.)

Allyn, Simeon (Conn). 1st Lieutenant of Mott's Connecticut State Regiment, June to December, 1776; Captain Connecticut Militia. Killed at Groton Heights, 6th September, 1781.

Allyn, Timothy (Conn). 1st Lieutenant of Webb's Continental Regiment, 1st January, 1777; Captain Lieutenant, 8th April, 1780; transferred to 3d Connecticut, 1st January, 1781; Captain, 8th February, 1781; retired 1st January, 1783.

Alner, James (N. Y.). 1st Lieutenant 1st New York, 28th June, 1775; Captain, 31st December, 1775, to — January, 1776; Major of Malcolm's Regiment New York Militia, June to December, 1776.

Alston, John (S. C.). Captain South Carolina Militia in 1775.

Allston, William (S. C.). Captain 2d South Carolina, 1779 to 1781. (Died 26th June, 1839.)

Alon, William (Pa). 1st Lieutenant 1st Pennsylvania Battalion of the Flying Camp, July to December, 1776.

Alvord, Job (Mass). 1st Lieutenant 21st Continental Infantry, 1st January to 31st December, 1776; Captain 4th Massachusetts, 1st January, 1777; retired 1st April, 1779; Captain Massachusetts Militia in 1780.

Amberson, William (Pa). 2d Lieutenant 8th Pennsylvania, 1st January, 1777; 1st Lieutenant, 2d October, 1777; wounded at Brandywine, 11th September, 1777; Aide-de-camp to General Lafayette in 1778 and 1779. (Died 13th December, 1829.)

Ambrose, Nathaniel (N. H.). Captain New Hampshire Militia, 1777-1778.

Ament, Eldred (N. Y.). Ensign 3d New York, 21st November, 1776; resigned 23d December, 1778.

Ames, Benjamin (Mass). Captain of Frye's Massachusetts Regiment, 19th April to December, 1775. (Died 1809.)

Ames, Jotham (Mass). Sergeant of Bailey's Massachusetts Regiment, May to December, 1775, and in the 23d Continental Infantry in 1776; 1st Lieutenant 2d Massachusetts, 1st January, 1777; Brevet Captain, 30th September, 1783, and served to close of war.

Ames, Seth (Mass). Surgeon's Mate of Thomas' Massachusetts Regiment, 1st September to December, 1775; Surgeon 13th Continental Infantry, 1st January to 31st December, 1776. (Died 1809.)

Amis, Thomas (N. C.). Commissary 3d North Carolina, 22d December, 1776, to —.

Amis, William (N. C.). Commissary 3d North Carolina, 6th May, 1776. Retired 1st December, 1776.

Amos, Aquilla (Md). Ensign 2d Maryland Battalion of the Flying Camp, July to December, 1776.

Ancrum, — (S. C.). Major South Carolina Militia; wounded at Stono Ferry, 20th June, 1779. (See Aneram—believed to be same.)

Anderson, Archibald (Md). 2d Lieutenant of Hindman's Independent Maryland Company, 14th January, 1776; 1st Lieutenant, September, 1776; Captain of 2d Maryland, 10th December, 1776; Major 3d Maryland, 10th June, 1777; Brigade Major Maryland Brigade, 16th June, 1778; killed at Guilford, 15th March, 1781.

Anderson, Augustine (N. J.). Ensign of Spencer's Continental Regiment, 17th February, 1777; omitted November, 1777. (Died 1834.)

Anderson, Daniel (Pa). Lieutenant 11th Pennsylvania. Dismissed 3d April, 1778. (Died 16th August, 1822.)

Anderson, Daniel (S. C.). Captain South Carolina Militia, 1779 to 1782.

Anderson, David (Va). Ensign 1st Virginia, 2d October, 1775, to —.

Anderson, Enoch (Del). 2d Lieutenant Delaware Regiment, 13th January, 1776; wounded at Long Island, 27th August, 1776; Captain, 3d December, 1776; resigned 1st March, 1779. (Died 4th March, 1820.)

Anderson, Enoch (Pa). 1st Lieutenant 11th Pennsylvania, 30th September, 1776; Captain, 7th October, 1777; cashiered, 3d April, 1778.

Anderson, Ephraim (N. J.). Major New Jersey Militia in 1775; Adjutant 2d New Jersey, 28th October, 1775, to 10th November, 1776; Captain 2d New Jersey, 29th November, 1776; killed at Short Hills, 26th June, 1777.

Anderson, Evan (Pa). Captain Pennsylvania Militia, 1780-1781.

Anderson, Isaac (Pa). Lieutenant Pennsylvania Militia, 1777-1780. (Died 1838.)
