John Alston, b. Scotland, grad. Glasgow U.. Came to America years before Revolutionary war. Commissioned by King George III as surveyor, settled on Cedar Creek in lower Fairfield C.

Maria Mary Buyl, a Scotch girl, who was rescued from shipwreck & brought to America on some vessel on which John Alston was passenger. The old brick house, their home, near Alston graveyard, was burned by Sherman in 1865.
