

Anderson leads Denver to victory over Kansas City

Winnsboro's Mike Anderson, a second-year runningback for Denver, led the Broncos to a 20-6 win over faltering Kansas City in Denver on Sunday.

Anderson carried the ball 22 times for 155 yards, and scored the first Denver touchdown on a 62-yard gallop in the opening quarter.

Anderson and Bronco receiver Rod Smith, who caught eight passes for 110 yards, together accounted for 90 percent of the Denver offense.

The victory kept Denver in with San Diego and Oakland for first place in the AFC West division
