S.C. settling on the Tygers 1763. Daw. Sarah
Anderson remained in Charleston - matron of orphan
House entertained Geo. W. at her table when he
visited Charleston as her guest - mar W^m
Breaken, had 1 son W^m - In old age lived
Tyger J. Anderson - When Gen Lincoln
surrendered in Charleston May 1780 the
British took possession of her house
