Subject: James and Owen Andrews

We have been unable find where James Andrews came from.

From his probate records that were recorded on July 23, 1798 James had the following family:

Wife-Priscilla, Children-Mathew, Pateance, Enoch, James, Edward, John, William, Owen and Mary who married a McGraw

Owen in listed in the 1790 Census for Fairfield County with 2 males over 16, 1 male under 16 and 3 females in his household

We did not find an Owen again until the 1830 Census; has him in Gwinnett Co., Ga. shows Owen being between 70 and 80 and a female in the house being between 50 and 60.

There was another Owen living in Gwinnett Co., Ga. in 1830 with 1 male under 5, one male between 30 and 40 and a female between 20 and 30, this could be the son of the above Owen.

In Find-A-Grave we found a record for Owen Andrews that was buried in the Andrews Cemetery in Liborn, Gwinnett Co. Ga., born 1753 and died September 5, 1847, there was no picture of a tombstone.

There is one land record of James Andrews conveying some land to Owen in 1794, but the land records do not show what Owen did with this land.

There are no probate records for Owen Andrews, you may be able find some in Gwinnett County, Ga.

Hope this is of some help.
