My great, great, great, greatgrand father, James Andrews (born about 1750, cork, Ireland) came to America on a sailing vessel with his sons Robert and John (born in cork, Ireland may 16, 1784) around 1795. They settled in Fairfield District. James Andrews died on Dec. 22, 1804. Can you locate and photocopy his death certificate?

John Andrews married Jane Blair (born in Ireland and came to America on the same vessel as John) on Feb. 8, 1810 - in Fairfield District. Can you locate and photocopy their marriage certificate?

Their 7th child, Diana Martha Andrews was born March 18, 1825, Fairfield Dist. She was my great, great grandmother. Can you locate and photocopy her birth certificate?

Any other information you have in your records concerning this family would be greatly appreciated! Wills, land grants, etc.!

The Andrews family lived in South Carolina until 1825 when they moved to Butts co. Ga.

How can I locate the sailing vessel's name, and what was its arrival port? Why did The Andrews family travel to South Carolina?


JAMES ANDEWS, who petitioned the South Carolina Council in Charles Town on 7 April 1752, is my fifth great-grandfather. He wrote a will on 28 October 1797 and died July 1798 in Fairfield County, South Carolina..

I am descended from JAMES' son, OWEN , who was in Franklin County, Georgia by 1800 and who died in Gwinnett County on 5 September 1846.

In the petition of 1752, he stated he had come from the northward about 16 years ago. Do you have any knowledge of where northward was or who his father may have been?
