JAMES ANDREWS – JOHN ANDREWS

James Andrews b. about 1750; d. Dec. 22, 1804, came from Ireland to America in 1790s with his son, John Andrews. On the same sailing vessel was Jane Blair, whom John married Feb. 8, 1810. More than one month was spent on this voyage. They settled in South Carolina, and lived for a number of years in Fairfield District.

About 1825 they moved to Butts County, Georgia and settled on land in the eastern part of the county near Stark. In the 1828 Tax List of Butts County, John Andrews and his brother, Robert, are listed in Captain Kirksey's District with several Andrews families.

John Andrews was a farmer. In his will of 1849, he mentioned living on Lot 98 of the First District of Butts County near John Beauchamp and Josiah W. Barber. The Andrews family attended Macedonia Baptist Church. John Andrews was born May 10, 1784 in Ireland; d. Dec. 17, 1849. Jane Blair Andrews d. Jan. 6, 1870. Their place of burial is not known.
