JAMES ANDREWS

IN THE NAME OF GOD AMEN

of State

I James Andrews of the County of Fairfield of South Carolina Being Reasonable well in Body Mind & Memory Thanks be to God for his Mercies & Calling to mind the mortality of my Body & that it is appointed for all men once to die; I therefore do make & ordain this My Last will & Testament in form & manner hereafter followeth utterly denying all other will or Instruments of writing made by me, & principally & first of all I desire To give my soul to God that give it & my Body when I die should be decently buried at the discretion of my Executors hereafter mentioned & Touching such worldly Effects as the Lord has Blesed me with I leave in form as followeth to wit .....

And first I desire that my loving wife Prifalah Andrews maybe mantaned out of my Estate should she be the Longest Liver -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Son Mathew Andrews the plantation or Tract of Land whereon I now live Containing Three hundred acres more or less formerly Granted to Isaac porcher & from Isaac porcher to Joseph Kerkland & from Joseph Kerkland to myself James Andrews -- with fifteen head of Cattle four head of horses fifty head of hogs three fathershead with my house Hold & Kitchen furniture also my farming & planting utenchels -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my daughter patience Wallis one Shilling Sterling -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Son Enoch Andrews one Shilling Sterling -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Son James Andrews one Shilling Sterling -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Son Edward Andrews one Shilling Sterling -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Son John Andrews one Shilling Sterling -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Son David Andrews one Shilling Sterling -----

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Son William Andrews one Shilling Sterling

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Son Ann Andrews one Shilling Sterling

Item. I Give & bequeath unto my Daughter Mary Andrews one Shilling Sterling

And Lastly I appoint my Son Edward Andrews with my Son Mathew Andrews-- The Sole Executors of this my Last will & Testament in witness whereof I have here unto Set my hand and Seal this 28<sup>th</sup> Day of October 1797
