Peter Arnett's Grant No. 2270
State of No. Carolina, Know ye that we for and in consideration of the sum of 50 shillings for every 100 acres hereby granted paid into our treasury by Peter Arnett have given and granted unto the said Peter Arnett a tract of land containing 200 lying and being in the County of Anson on the waters of Brown Creek adjoining his own. Beginning at a hickory by two hickorys and a post in Browns line. . . .
(other description) . . . to Webbs corner red oak, . . . etc...
No. 193. Entered 10th March 1807, No. 364 Entered 20th October 1808 at Raleigh the 28th day of Nov. in the 39 year of our Independence and in the year of our Lord 1814. By Command
