Land leaving at her death two infant children viz Frances Land & Sarah Land, my grand children my 2nd Dgt the wife of Herndon Chalk the above children I did directly & indirectly give in the whole sum \$2000. from various sources by Reference to deeds &c. in the Clerk & Commissioners office of Chester District in this State, to explain more fully I did at the time of dividing divide nearly Equal at that time since that time by my Prudence and industry together with various legacies from my last wife's grand Father the

Collected the Property I am now
attempting to dispose off, and hoping
that the authorities to whom
this may come well in behalf
of my Respected Family sustain
this my last will as follows
my children by my Present
wife Eliza T. Arnette shall Receive
\$2000 Each as they arrive at the
age of 21 yrs. or age to give there
mother a receipt for the same
and then she shall Remain in
full possession of all my Estate
after my Just Debts is paid. Sell
or let & her acts shall be good
that is Remain in full possession
of all as though I was living and
she Dead that she may not be
subject to her children, at her
death then the Ballance of
what she may leave if any shall
be Equally divided by all my
children. The first two shares to
my Deceased Dgts' children if
they be living if not, but
one share that is to Sarah Chalk
or her heirs & my Two oldest sons
is duly appointed my Executors.

to carry out this my last will
no acts by law is to be had in
this my will only by my
wife Eliza R. Arnett as I have
before said as though I was
living in place of her we have
4 children viz John Teaster Arnett
Beny Ann Arnett these are
appointed as I before said to
carry out my Will and they
shall receive for the same \$100
each at settling up and closing
the Estate my wife to make
no distinction in giving one
of her children more than the
other Except in Contract to attend
and assist her in carrying out her
wishes my next youngest children
Susan Rebecca Arnett + Robert Samuel
Arnette all of which I hope will be
properly understood and sustained
in my Every Prayer Amen
I find is that I have 2 illegitimate
Children in the District of Chester
and State of S.C. and now
living on SOA of Land the same
I give and beq to them at
my death viz Thos Roberts
and Perlira Roberts children

McClerkin is hereby appointed
their trustee to carry out the
same in witness whereof I
have hereunto set my hand &
seal this 12th day of Nov. 1855
