ABSTRACTS FROM MISSISSIPPI DAR APPLICATION RECORDS

The following abstracts were taken from information compiled by the Mississippi Daughters of the American Revolution from chapter files of application papers submitted for NSDAR membership in the Mississippi Society. It was published in a revised and updated form in 1979. The listing shows the ancestor's last name first, followed by his/her given name, rank and state from which he served, the date and place of birth, death and marriage, where known; the name of spouse, and any dates of children with any identifying information in connection with the children of the ancestor. These abstracts were selected from entries that refer to a South Carolina connection for service, birth, marriage or death. It may be important to remember that many families passed through South Carolina in a migration pattern extending from Pennsylvania to Texas. Many of the families may have lived in South Carolina only a short while, but they may have left parents, children, brothers or sisters in the area; these connections may assist current researchers in piecing together family groups that became separated in the "western migration." o follow p on information in these abstracts,

Marriage notices and implied marriages from the Fairfield Herald, August 1, 1866 to October 5, 1876, and The News and Herald, October 12, 1876 to February 24, 1916. Both of these newspapers were published in Winnsboro, South Carolina. These papers had a tri-weekly edition and a weekly edition. Because more issues of the weekly edition remain, the vast majority of the marriage notices are from the weekly edition, which was published on Wednesday. Because of missing issues there are gaps in the notices. The main gap is between 1907 and 1916. There were no issues for 1907 through 1910 and only a few for issues for 1911 through 1916. Many of the notices appeared in two issues and the issue that contained all pertinent information is listed. There are a few notices that are listed twice because all pertinent information was not included in either notice

June 3, 1885 Issue

Joseph F. **Arledge** married (1) Annie **Arledge**, and (2) Priscilla Nichols in 1873. Mrs. Nichols was Miss **Arledge**, sister of Joseph F. **Arledge**

November 11, 1885 Issue

On October 28th at the residence of the bride's father, Major Culp, at Rossville, Miss Laura Culp to Mr. Richard W. **Featherston**, by the Rev. C. G. Bradford.

September 22, 1897 Issue

J. R. **Arledge** married Sallie C. Lyles, daughter of Nathan and Elizabeth T. Lyles on July 29, 1875

These death notices are from the Fairfield Herald, July 4, 1866 to September 6, 1876, and The News and Herald, October 19, 1876 to February 24, 1916. Both newspapers were published in Winnsboro, South Carolina. These papers had a tri-weekly edition and a weekly edition. The majority of the death notices are from the weekly edition, which was published on Wednesday. Because of the missing issues there are large gaps in the death notices. This is especially true from 1907 to 1916, as there are no issues for the years 1907 through 1910 and a very few for the remaining years.

May 13, 1885 Issue

Mr. J. F. **Arledge**, who resided in the Rocky Mount section, died on Monday at the age of about seventy. He leaves a wife and one child, Mrs. Wylie Davis of Ridgeway.

June 3, 1885 Issue

Mr. Joseph F. **Arledge**, who died about two weeks ago in Winnsboro was born in the Rocky Mount neighborhood on October 28, 1818. His first marriage was to his cousin, Annie **Arledge**, the mother of his only surviving child, Mrs. Wylie Davis of Ridgeway. In 1873 he married Priscilla Nichols, who survive him. He also leaves two brothers, Dr. J. R. **Arledge** and Mr. Saml. T. **Arledge**, and one sister, Mrs. Nichols.

December 2, 1891 Issue

Mrs. Sallie A. Davis, wife of Mr. Wylie J. Davis, died on November 27th in Ridgeway from a stroke of paralysis. She leaves, beside her husband two children: Miss Beulah Davis and R. W. **Featherston**.

August 4, 1897 Issue

Mrs. Thomas Devault died Sunday. She was buried at Popular Spring Church. Boyce **Featherston**, son of Mr. and Mrs. **Featherston**, died on Sunday. He was buried Bethesda.

August 4, 1897 Issue

Dr. J. R. **Arledge** died at his home near Winnsboro on Monday, at the age of 72. He was buried at the Lyles Cemetery.

September 22, 1897 Issue

Dr. J. R. **Arledge** died on August 2nd at the age of 73. He was born on January 12, 1825 and on July 29, 1875 married Miss Sallie C. Lyles, a daughter of Nathan and Elizabeth T. Lyles. His was buried in the Lyles Family Burying Ground.

Mabry Hill married Rachel **Arledge**, daughter of Isaac **Arledge**.

In his Will, Isaac **Arlege** stated: "My daughter married Mabry Hill." Deed Book 0, rage 369, Fairfield County, S. C., Aug. 25, 1798. "I, Mabry Hill and Rachel Hill his wife of the County of Fairfield and State aforesaid do hereby acknowledge to have received of Isaac and William **Arledge** of the said county, the sum of 20 lbs. sterling money being in full for all our part of the estate of Isaac **Arledge**, Sr., deceased which legacy left in the last will and testament of said Isaac **Arledge**, senior,. There-the said Mabry and Rachel Hill for ourselves and our heirs do empower Isaac and William **Arledge** to demand -- administer and enjoy all the profits from said estate __" Aug. 25th, 1798.

Mabry Hill was not shown on the 1790 census of Fairfield. One Richard Hill was shown near: Tho. Goodrum, Tidwell, Isaac Gibson, Bishop, **Arledge** and Joseph Clements. Richard Hill, One male over 16 years (himself), 2 males under 16 years and one female.'

Some years after the death of Mr. Jones Sallie married Wylie J. Davis. This did not prove a very happy union, and in a few years they separated. During Sallie's life Wylie J. Davis married Mrs. R. D. **Featherstone**, daughter of Joseph F. **Arledge**.

Richard Gaithers daughter Nancy married James Bailey and her children were Richard, Robert C. Sallie and Mary. Richard died in young manhood. Robert C. married Miss Sarah **Arledge** who bore to him Charlotte, Susan, Sallie James, Richard, and Mary. Charlotte married James Benson, and bore several children, all went to Poinsett Co., Ark. Charlotte and Benson are both dead, but they
