George Ashford died 31 July 1814 intestate. ¹⁰ His wife must have died prior to his death, because she was not listed in his will, nor in the division of his estate. His property (every item) was sold at a public auction on 14 and 15 November 1814. ¹¹ The proceeds of the sale amounted to \$2,633.42. George and Micajah were named executors of their father's will, but Micajah handled all details of executing it. The reason for this being, Micajah lived with, or near, his father, but his brother, George, lived several miles across the Broad River in Fairfield County.

The following children of George are known to have owned land in Fairfield County, South Carolina: George, Jr.; James; Bennett; William; and Simon. Moses owned land in Union County, South Carolina.
