

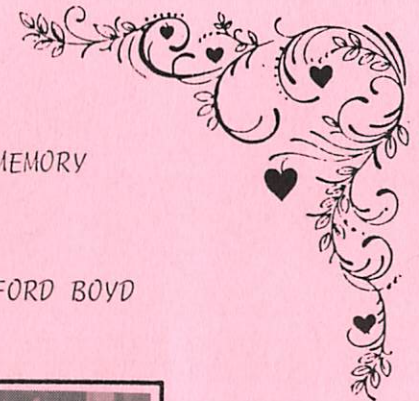
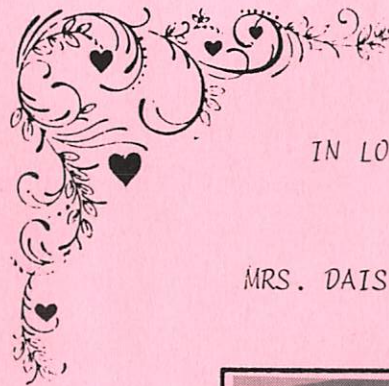
HEAVEN'S GROCERY STORE

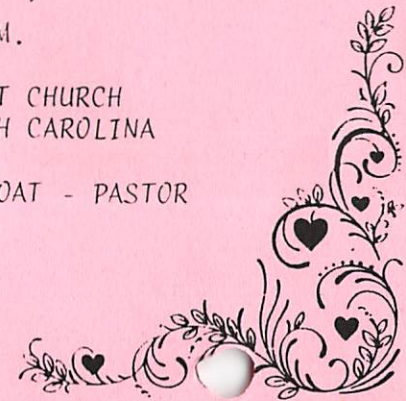
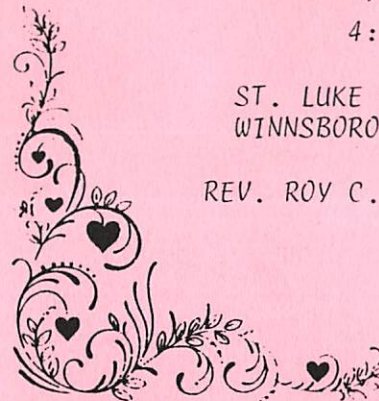
