I am sorry what I sent you was all I was able to find in our collection.

The cemetery page and funeral program were the only Mills in our collection.

The census pages were all I could find for your Henry Mills family.

The death certificates found may or may not be children of your Henry Mills family.

I can say that there is mention of a slave master Mills that prayed morning and sunset with his slaves in the slave narrative collection.

No mention of any of the slave names or master Mills name.

There is a Henry Mills in the militia 1869 rolls and often the slaves would take on the name of the slave master; especially if he was good to them.

However, that is all I can find on Henry Mills also.

Township 14 is the town of Winnsboro, so they may not have been on a plantation, but worked in a store, or trade or at the town home.

I have attached a paid-researcher list from the SC Archives that may have someone that can be of more assistance.

I know it can be frustrating, but I hope you are able to find more soon,
