Colonel Richard Lee, born in England - came to Virginia about 1639, and settled first in York County, Virginia, later in Westmoreland County. He was attorney general of Virginia in 1642 - was a member of the House of Burgesses for York County at the session November 1647, and for Northumberland County March 1651. He was appointed member of the Council in 1651 and was Secretary of State 1649 - 1652. He married Ann ^{Countess?} and died 1664. He had a son Charles Lee of Cobbs Hall, Northumberland - born about 1656 - died 1700. He was a justice of Northumberland County 1687 - 1699. He married in 1721 Elizabeth Pritchard and had a son Charles Lee of Cobbs Hall - born Nov. 2, 1722 - died October 1747. He married his cousin Mary daughter of Richard and Judith Steptoe Lee of Dutchley - had a son Charles Lee of Cobbs Hall - born Mar 9, 1744 - died March 1785. He married Sarah Hull - (born 1740 - died 1827). They had a son John who moved to what is now Liberty Hill, South Carolina. John Lee married Mary Elizabeth Dixon they had a daughter Mary Elizabeth Lee who married James Nevin, a distant cousin who came to Liberty Hill from Fairfax, Virginia.
