Col. Richard Lee, born in England, came to America (Virginia) about 1642^{1639 or}, and settled in York County, Va., later in Westmoreland County.

He was Attorney General of Va. in 1642 and was a member of the House of Burgesses for York County at the session 1647, and for Westmoreland County, March 1651.

He was appointed member of the Council in 1651, and was Secretary of State in 1649-1652.

He married Ann ? and died in 1664.

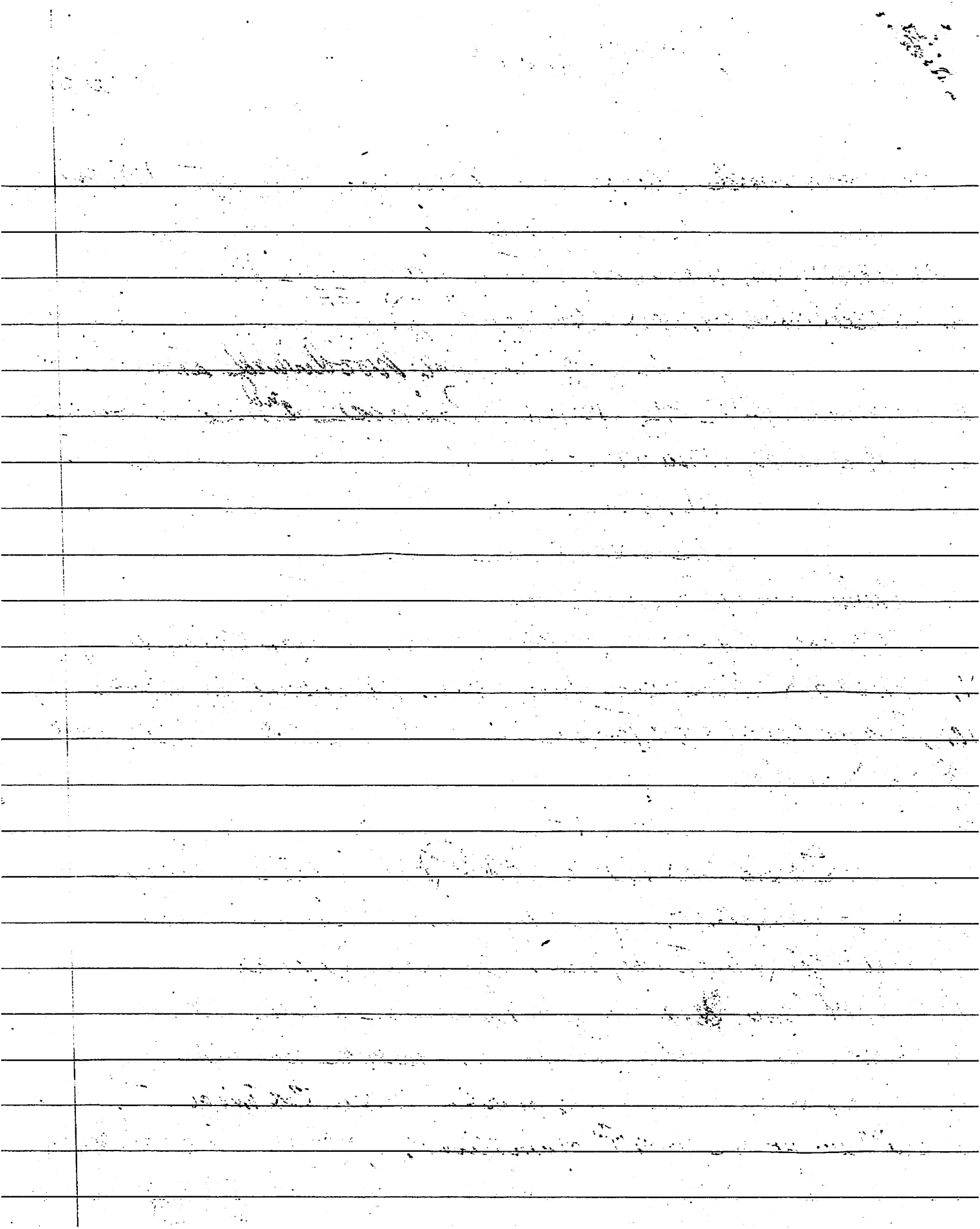

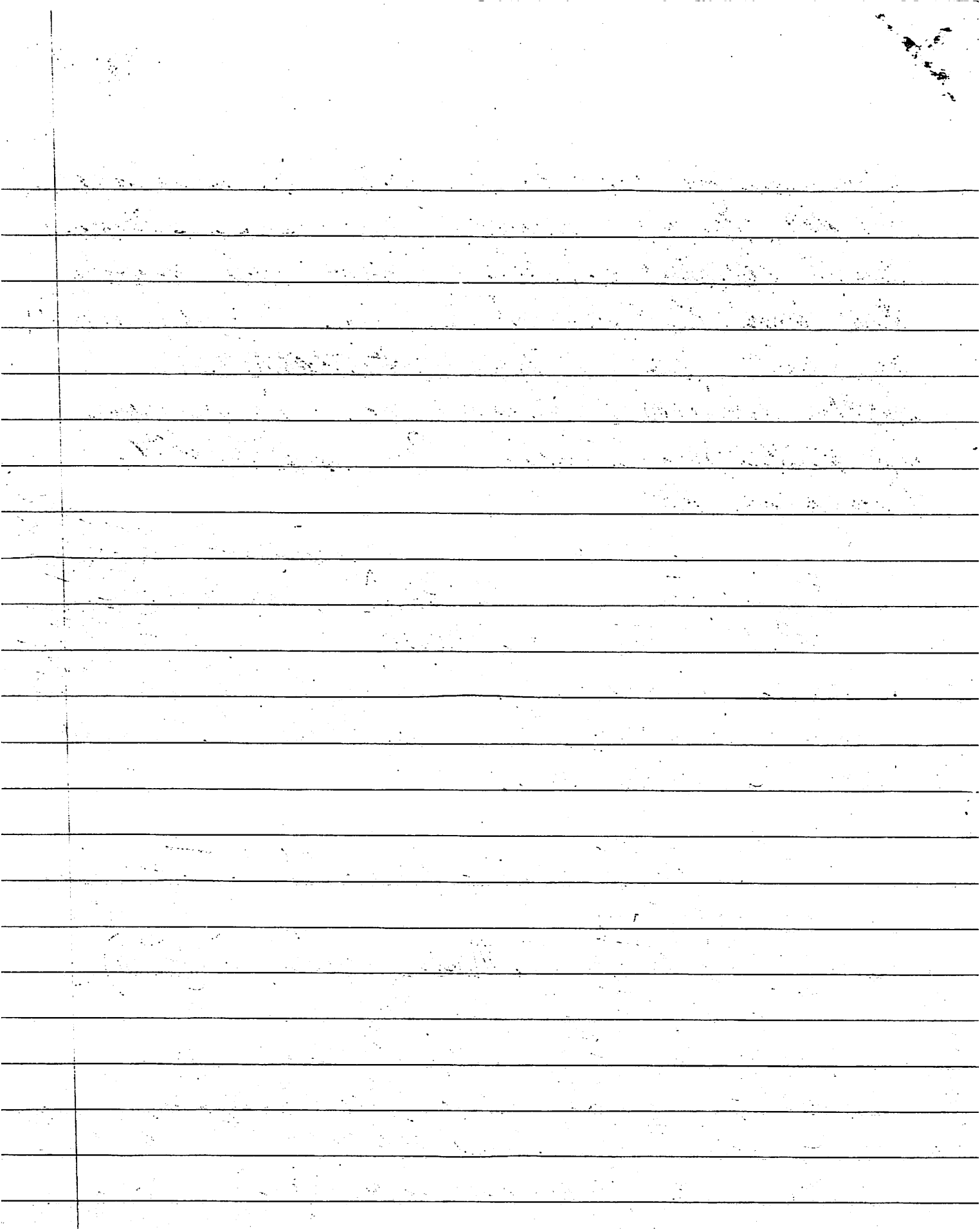
